INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE & STRATEGY

The Fund intends to achieve for its participants total returns consisting of current income and capital growth. The fund aims to achieve a rate of return higher than the bid price of 10-year Republic of the Philippines (ROP) Bonds from Bloomberg Generic (BGN) at the start of the quarter.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

The Bank of Commerce Diversity Dollar Bond Fund is suitable only for investors who:





RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The fund has savings deposit with Bank proper amounting to US\$ 5,007.55 which is 0.37% of the fund. The said funds is for disposition to ROP Bonds & Dollar Time Deposit. Bank of Commerce is an approved counterparty by the Trust and Investment Committee and the Board of Directors. All related party transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

Last March 24, the USDPHP opened higher at 48.690 from previous close of 48.631. Traded within the range of 48.700 - 48.665 on risk off sentiment, before eventually closing at 48.665. Meanwhile, US Treasury yields tumbled yet another 3bps on the ave. ROP & INDON prices recovered, in sync with the move on USTs as long-term inflation concerns are dismissed by Fed Chair Powell and bolstered by the full employment expectations by Treasury Sec Yellen. On the FX side, greenback shrugs off yields and continued to rise. For week-term, wider range expected between 48.55-48.75. Meanwhile, foreign direct investments (FDI) registered US\$509 million net inflows in December 2020, 62.6 percent lower than the US\$1.4 billion net inflows recorded in December 2019. On an annual basis, total FDI net inflows in 2020 amounted to US\$6.5 billion, or a contraction of 24.6 percent, from US\$8.7 billion net inflows in 2019. The disruptive impact of the pandemic on global supply chains and the weak business outlook adversely affected investor decisions in 2020.

Forecast/Outlook: Forecast for USD/PHP (Average) is 48.50-49.50 while USD/PHP (Year-End) is 49.00-50.00.

The following are the fund's strategy and considerations:

1. The fund is invested in long duration dollar bonds and high yielding time deposits to service liquidity requirements of the participants.
2. The fund will continue to invest on USD Denominated Bonds - ROPs to increase the portfolio duration and sustain return through interest income.
3. It will retain the current portfolio profile and investment strategy as global markets remain volatile and the market sentiment on the rate cuts made / near zero rate target by the FED.
